HOLINESS by Chad Stafko is now shipping from Lambert Book House.

HOLINESS is a practical guide to holy living that teaches how to block the negative stimuli of the world, achieve holiness, and please God. In 160 pages and 15 chapters, author Chad Stafko leads us through a much needed study that considers the importance of biblical holiness in our spiritual lives and examines whether God actually commands His people to be holy. This valuable book demonstrates how holiness can bring us through the trials of life to greater faith, contentment, happiness, and assurance for the future.

Stafko writes, “Not only is every Christian capable of being holy, but God actually demands that his people be holy. The Apostle Paul described members of the Church at both Colossae and Ephesus as being holy (Colossians 1:3; Ephesians 1:4). Note that Paul did not describe as holy only the leaders at each respective congregation, but instead labeled as holy *all the members* at each location. God goes beyond examples and encouragement to be holy when He *commands* us to be holy. In Hebrews 12:14, God says, “Make every effort to live in peace with all men and to be holy; without holiness no one will see the Lord.”

HOLINESS is organized around a well-constructed method for analyzing God-given examples for holiness. Individual chapters consider David, Joseph, Noah, Daniel, Joshua, Paul, and Jesus Christ. Between analyses, chapters focus on personal analysis and challenges to leading a holy life, as well as developing, increasing, and fostering holiness.

Chad Stafko has published extensively in the areas of business and religion, and has written articles for Gospel Advocate. Chad and his wife Heather have two sons, Tyler and Camden. Chad is a deacon at Green Mount road church of Christ in Belleville, Illinois.
